Aftercare typically includes:  
Activity restricted to a 3 foot leash held in a human hand, Cage Rest, Daily Physical Therapy exercises, Elizabethan or Comfy Cone collar, Bandage changes, K - Laser© treatments, Adequan© injections, post surgical x-rays and progress exams with the primary care veterinarian, and Dr. Moss.

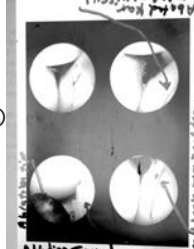

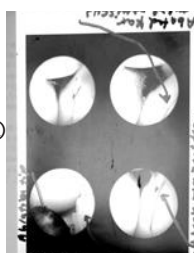

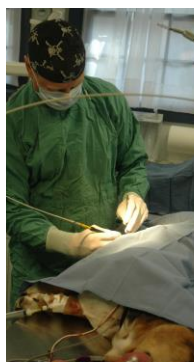
